Whitey Moore contributed thirteen victories to the Cincinnati pennant winners last year. It was his best season with the Reds and gave promise for even better ones. Moore is one of the fastest pitchers in the National League but has been hampered by lack of control which he should get with more experience. This is only his third full season with the Reds. Bill McKechnie, who has been guiding the young pitcher slowly, put him in as a relief hurler in the World Series games last year, and Moore held the Yankees runless and hitless for three innings.
