ORDINANCE NO. 726

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE SIX OF THE VILLAGE ZONING CODE

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Tuscarawas, Tuscarawas County, Ohio has determined that it is in the interest of the community and for reasons of safety and welfare of its residents that an ordinance be passed amending Article Six of the Village Zoning Code currently in place within the Village;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Tuscarawas as follows:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Code currently in place within the Village of Tuscarawas shall be amended as follows:

- A. Section 600.1 (e) shall be deleted in its entirety.
- B. Section 601.5 shall have the phrase "or covered with a securely tied tarp" added at the end of the section.
- C. Section 601.6 shall be amended to allow two commercial vehicles.

SECTION 2. The foregoing Ordinance was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Village of Dennison, Tuscarawas County, Ohio relating thereto were conducted in open meetings to the public in compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by Council and shall become effective upon passage by Council.
