ORDINANCE NO. 600

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. <u>559</u> OF THE VILLAGE OF TUSCARAWAS, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tuscarawas, Ohio as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> That Zoning Ordinance No. <u>559</u> of the Village of Tuscarawas. Tuscarawas County, Ohio is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten herein.

<u>Section 2:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after the date of its approval and adoption, as provided by law. This Ordinance was passed as an emergency Ordinance by the Council of the Village of Tuscarawas.


<u>Section 3:</u> This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Tuscarawas, Ohio and for the further reason that immediate action needs to be taken to update the Village's zoning ordinance with regard to the location of accessory buildings in the rear yard.

EXHIBIT "A"

505.1 No accessory buildings shall be located in any front or side yard except under unusual circumstances where such activity shall not conflict with the intent and purpose of this Ordinance; or, where enforcement shall result in extreme hardship. Either exception shall require approval of the Board. Accessory buildings such as garages may be located in the rear yard provided such buildings are set back at least three (3) feet from the side lot line and six (6) feet from the rear lot lines.
